GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

All cattle must have **CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION** (follow state rules). All breeding animals 4 months of age and older must be calf hood vaccinated. Steers are exempt.

1. Each exhibitor will be limited to (2) entries per breeding dairy class.
2. All animals must be clipped, groomed, and broke to show.
3. Dairy Cattle may begin entering the fairgrounds at 12 noon, Sunday, September 17th.
4. All Dairy cattle must be in place and milked out by 6 pm. Sunday, September 17th.
5. Dairy Cattle Exhibitor Meeting Monday, September 18th, at 9:30 am.
6. Dairy Cattle show begins Monday, September 18th, at 10 am. Show will follow order of fair book and then continue in order by breeds. (Exp. Jersey, Brown Swiss, Holstein, other).
7. Showmanship contest will be determined by judge, before or after dairy show.
8. Milking animals may be released following show; all others are based on overcrowding and/or must be determined by Dairy Superintendent.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSIFICATIONS

Junior Get-of Sire: Two offspring out of the same sire owned and shown by junior exhibitor.

Best of Three Females: Any age, all are to have been bred and owned by junior exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry.

Breeder's Get-of-Sire: Two offspring out of the same sire.

Produce of Dam: Group to consist of two animals, any age, the produce of one cow. The dam must be named. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry from the same cow. Animals need not both be owned by the exhibitor.

Breeding Dairy – Division 1

1. Each exhibitor will be limited to (2) entries per breeding dairy class.
2. Open show is offered in breeding division and will follow Jr. Show with same show format.
3. All first place winners from Jr. entries may crossover to open divisions automatically, unless there are class registrations. Therefore, Jr. entry winner will compete in open. Ribbons NOT points are earned in Open show, only if open entries are entered.

20. Aged cow, seven years old and over born before Sept 1, 2016
21. Dry cow, any age (must have completed one lactation)
